1.0 SCOPE. This document contains requirements to restore the Memory Cartridge for the SB-3865 and AN/TTC-42(V), NSN 5895-01-370-2418, CAGE 28528, Part Number 1335700G1 to Condition Code "A". Condition Code A is defined as "serviceable/issuable without qualification, new, used, repaired or reconditioned materiel which is serviceable and issuable to all customers without limitation or restriction, including materiel with more than 6 months shelf-life remaining".

1.1 This Statement of Work (SOW) identifies the work effort including repair, testing, and packaging/marketing requirements that shall be performed by the contractor to rebuild the Memory Cartridge for the SB-3865 and AN/TTC-42(V), NSN 5895-01-370-2418, CAGE 28528, Part Number 1335700G1.

2.0 Applicable Documents. The following documents form a part of this SOW to the extent specified. Unless otherwise specified, the issues of these documents are those listed in the DoD Index of Specifications and Standards (DoDISS) and supplement thereto which is in effect on the date of solicitation. In the event of conflict between the documents referenced herein and the contents of this SOW, the contents of this SOW shall be the superseding requirement.

3.0 Requirements

3.1 The contractor shall rebuild the Memory Cartridge for the SB-3865 and AN/TTC-42(V) in accordance with RS 08440A-50 and the following Engineering Drawings: 1335700, 1335715, 789363, PL789363-1 and PL789363-2.

3.2 Packaging, Handling, Storage and Transportation (PHS&T).

a. The contractor shall be responsible for preservation and packaging of items being repaired under the terms of this statement of work. Items being prepared for long term storage and/or shipment to overseas destinations shall be preserved and packaged in accordance with Level "A" requirements of MIL-STD-2073-1C, Appendix A, Table J.Ia, Specialized Equipment Preservation Code "GX". Items being prepared for domestic shipment or immediate use shall be to Level "B" requirements. All items subject to damage by electrostatic discharge shall be packed into a reusable fast pack container.

b. Marking of all items shall be in accordance with MIL-STD-129.

c. The Marine Corps will provide the Contractor with the shipping address(es) for delivery of the repaired equipment. The Contractor shall be responsible for arranging for shipment to the pre-designated site(s). The Marine Corps will be responsible for transportation costs associated with shipping the subject equipment to and from the Contractor.
