

STATEMENT OF WORK FOR THE
 Rebuild of the
 M939/M939A1 Series 5-Ton Truck
 Transfer and Container, Model T-138-1,
 NSN 2520-00-089-3773

1.0 SCOPE. This document contains requirements to restore the Transfer and Container for the M939/M939A1 Series 5-ton trucks to condition code 'A.' Condition code 'A' is defined as serviceable/issuable without qualification, new, used, repaired, or reconditioned material which is serviceable and issuable to all customers without limitation or restriction.

1.1 This Statement of Work (SOW) identifies the work effort that shall be performed by the contractor to rebuild the Transfer and Container, Model T-138-1, NSN 2520-00-089-3773, ID #80110C.

2.0 Applicable Documents. The following documents form a part of this SOW to the extent specified.

3.0 Requirements

3.1 General. The contractor shall repair and/or overhaul the Transfer and Container in accordance with DMWR 9-2520-507.

3.2 Quality Assurance Provisions. The Contractor shall provide and maintain a Quality System that, as a minimum, adheres to the requirements of ANSI/ISO/ASQC Q9003-1994, Quality System Model for Quality Assurance in Final Inspection and Test.

3.3 Configuration Control. If it is necessary to depart from the DMWR's authorized Bill of Material, the Contractor shall submit a Request for Deviation/Request for Waiver using MIL-STD-973, paragraph 5.4.3 and 5.4.4 as guidance.

3.4 Packaging, Handling, Storage and Transportation (PHS&T).

a. The contractor shall be responsible for the preservation of items being repaired under the terms of this SOW. Preservation and packing shall be in accordance with the Special Packaging Instruction (SPI) AK00893773 which may be obtained from G3 Logistics Operations Department, Attn: Storage and Distribution, G330, 814 Radford Boulevard, Suite 20330, Albany, GA 31704-0330, Commercial (912) 439-6856, DSN 567-6856.

b. Marking shall be in accordance with MIL-STD-129.

c. The Marine Corps will provide the contractor with the shipping address(es) for delivery of the repaired equipment. The contractor shall be responsible for arranging for shipment to the pre-designated site(s). The Marine Corps will be responsible for transportation costs associated with shipping the subject equipment to and from the contractor.

3.5 Government Furnished Equipment (GFE)/Government Furnished Materiel (GFM). GFE is government owned equipment authorized by contract for use by a commercial/Government contractor. It is neither consumed during production or incorporated into any product. GFM is materiel furnished to a contractor that will be consumed during the course of production or incorporated into the product being manufactured/remanufactured under a contract/statement of work. In the event the Marine Corps does have GFE/GFM requirements the Management Control Activity (MCA/G316-2), Marine Corps Logistics Bases, Albany, Georgia, will coordinate required GFE and will maintain a central control on Marine Corps assets in the Contractor's

possession. The MCA will forward GFE Accountability agreement to the Contractor Facility for signature to establish a chain of custody and property responsibilities for Marine Corps assets.

3.6 Contractor Furnished Materiel (CFM). The Marine Corps has adopted the Navy's procedures regarding Contractor Furnished Materiel (NAVICPINST 4491.21A). In the event that Contractor Furnished Materiel (CFM) is required for repair parts, the contractor shall requisition repair parts through the DOD Supply System. DOD 4000.25-1-M (MILSTRIP), Chapter 11 authorizes contractors to requisition through the DOD Supply System.
