

STATEMENT OF WORK (SOW)  
REBUILD OF  
CYLINDER HEADS FOR ENGINE DIESEL, AVDS 1790-2DA  
NSN 2815-00-150-7405

1.0 SCOPE. This document contains requirements to restore the Cylinder Heads for the Engine Diesel, AVDS 1790-2DA to condition code "A." Condition code "A" is defined as servicable/issuable without qualification, new, repaired, or reconditioned material which is serviceable and issuable to all customers without limitation or restriction.

1.1 This Statement of Work (SOW) identifies the work effort that shall be performed by the contractor to rebuild the Cylinder Heads for the Engine Diesel, AVDS 1790-2DA, NSN 2815-00-150-7405 in support of the AVLB, ID# 08940A, TAMCN E0150, NSN 5420-00-889-2020.

### 3.0 Requirements.

3.1 The contractor shall rebuild the Cylinder Heads in accordance with DMWR 9-2815-220.

3.2 Quality acceptance and test procedures shall be performed in accordance with DMWR 9-2815-220.

3.3 Quality Assurance Provision. The contractor shall provide and maintain a Quality System that as a minimum adheres to the requirements of ANSI/ISO/ASQC Q9003-1994, Quality Systems Model for Quality Assurance in Final Inspection and Test.

3.4 Configuration Management. If it is necessary to depart from the authorized configuration, the contractor shall submit a Request for Deviation or Request for Waiver using MIL-STD-973, paragraphs 5.4.3 or 5.4.4 as guidance.

3.5 Government Furnished Equipment (GFE)/Government Furnished Materiel (GFM). GFE is government owned equipment authorized by contract for use by a commercial/government contractor. It is neither consumed during production nor incorporated into any product. GFM is material furnished to a contractor that will be consumed during the course of production or incorporated into the product being manufactured/remanufactured under a contract/statement of work. In the event the Marine Corps does have GFE/GFM requirements, the Management Control Activity (MCA/G316-2), Marine Corps Logistics Bases, Albany, Georgia, will coordinate required GFE and will maintain a central control on Marine Corps assets in the contractors possession. The MCA will forward a GFE Accountability agreement to the Contractors Facility for signature to establish a chain of custody and property responsibilities for Marine Corps assets.

3.6 Contractor Furnished Materiel. The Marine Corps has adopted the Navy's procedures regarding Contractor Furnished Material (NAVICPINST 4491.2A). In the event that Contractor Furnished Material is required for repair parts, the contractor shall requisition through the DoD Supply System. DoD 4000.25-1-M, (MILSTRIP) Chapter 11 authorizes contractors to requisition through the DoD Supply System.

### 3.7 Packaging, Handling, Storage, and Transportation (PHS&T).

a. The contractor shall be responsible for preservation and packaging of items being repaired under the terms of this statement of work. Items being prepared for shipment shall be in accordance with SPI AK01507405 which may be obtained from G3 Logistics Operations Department, Attn: Storage and Distribution, G330; 814 Radford Boulevard, Suite 20330; Albany, Georgia 31704-0330, Commercial (912) 439-6856, DSN 567-6856.

b. Marking shall be in accordance with MIL-STD-129.

c. The Marine Corps will provide the contractor with the shipping address(es) for delivery of the rebuilt equipment. The contractor shall be responsible for arranging for shipment to the pre-designated site(s). The Marine Corps will be responsible for transportation cost associated with shipping the subject equipment to and from the contractor.
