

STATEMENT OF WORK FOR THE
Rebuild of the DC POWER SUPPLY ASSEMBLY FOR THE SB-3614(V)/TT
NSN: 6130-01-027-2839

1.0 SCOPE. This document contains requirements to restore the DC Power Supply Assembly for the SB-3614(V)/TT, NSN 6130-01-027-2839, CAGE 87990, Part Number 755090A0500 to Condition Code "A". Condition Code A is defined as "serviceable/issuable without qualification, new, used, repaired or reconditioned materiel which is serviceable and issuable to all customers without limitation or restriction, including materiel with more than 6 months shelf-life remaining.

1.1 This Statement of Work (SOW) identifies the work effort including repair, testing, and packaging/marketing requirements that shall be performed by the contractor to rebuild the DC Power Supply Assembly for the SB-3614(V)/TT, NSN 6130-01-027-2839 , CAGE 87990 , Part Number 755090A0500.

2.0 Applicable Documents. The following documents form a part of this SOW to the extent specified. Unless otherwise specified, the issues of these documents are those listed in the DoD Index of Specifications and Standards (DoDISS) and supplement thereto which is in effect on the date of solicitation. In the event of conflict between the documents referenced herein and the contents of this SOW, the contents of this SOW shall be the superseding requirement.

3.0 Requirements

3.1 The contractor shall rebuild the DC Power Supply Assembly for the SB-3614(V)/TT in accordance with DMWR 11-5805-695 and Engineering Drawings 755090A0500, DL755090A0500, PL755090A0500, 755090A0501, 755090A0502, 755090A0504, PL755090A0504, 755090A0505, PL755090A0505, 755090A0506, 755090A0508, and T-10619.

3.2 Packaging, Handling, Storage and Transportation (PHS&T)

a. The contractor shall be responsible for preservation and packaging of items being repaired under the terms of this statement of work. Items being prepared for long term storage or shipment to overseas destinations shall be preserved and packaged in accordance with level "A"

requirements of MIL-STD-2073-1C, Appendix A, Table A.VI., Electronic Equipment. Items being prepared for domestic shipment or immediate use shall be to level "B" requirements.

b. Marking shall be in accordance with MIL-STD-129.

c. The Marine Corps will provide the Contractor with the shipping address(es) for delivery of the rebuilt equipment. The Contractor shall be responsible for arranging for shipment to the pre-designated site(s). The Marine Corps will be responsible for transportation costs associated with shipping the subject equipment to and from the Contractor.

3.3 Configuration Control. The contractor shall implement configuration control to established configuration items. Deviation from the established baseline configuration will not be allowed without the approval in writing from the Weapon System/Equipment Manager (Code 847-3). If it is necessary to temporarily depart from the authorized configuration, the contractor shall prepare and submit a Request for Deviation or Request for Waiver using MIL-STD-973, paragraph 5.4.3 or 5.4.4, and subparagraphs and Appendix E, as a guide. Any proposed permanent departures to the configuration baseline affecting form, fit, or function, shall require an Engineering Change Proposal using MIL-STD-973, paragraph 5.4.2 and Appendix D as a guide.

3.4 Government Furnished Equipment (GFE)/Government Furnished Materiel (GFM). GFE is government owned equipment authorized by contract for use by a commercial/government contractor. It is neither consumed during the production nor incorporated into any product. GFM is materiel furnished to a contractor that will be consumed during the course of production or incorporated into product being manufactured/remanufactured under a contract/statement of work. In the event the Marine Corps does have GFE/GFM requirements, the Management Control Activity (MCA/Code 822), Marine Corps Logistics Bases, Albany, Georgia, will coordinate required GFE and will maintain a central control on Marine Corps assets in the Contractor's possession. The MCA will forward a GFE Accountability agreement to the Contractor Facility for signature to establish a chain of custody and property responsibilities for Marine Corps assets. The Contractor shall report receipt of all GFM and report consumption of GFM to the MCA.

3.5 Quality Assurances Provisions. The contractor shall provide and maintain a Quality System that as a minimum, adheres to the requirements of ANSI/ISO/ASQC Q9003-1994, Quality System Model for Quality Assurance in Final Inspection and Test.

3.6 Contractor Furnished Materiel. The Marine Corps has adopted the Navy's procedures regarding Contractor Furnished Materiel (NAVICPINST 4491.2A). In the event Contractor Furnished Materiel is required for repair parts, the contractor shall requisition through the DoD Supply System. DoD 4000.25-1-M, (MILSTRIP) Chapter 11 authorizes contractors to requisition through the DoD Supply System.

3.7 All work performed on electrical and electronic parts and assemblies during the rebuild shall be performed in accordance with EIA-625 to minimize the negative effects of electrostatic discharge on electronic parts, assemblies, and equipment.
