1.0 SCOPE. These documents contain requirements to restore the Light Armored Vehicle-25 M36E2 Body Assembly, Daylight to Condition Code "A." Condition Code "A" is defined as serviceable/issuable without qualification, new, used, repaired, or reconditioned material which is serviceable and issuable to all customers without limitation or restriction.

1.1 This Statement of Work (SOW) identifies the work effort that shall be performed by the contractor (for the purposes of this SOW, contractor is defined as the commercial or government entity performing the repair) to repair the M36E2 Body Assembly, Daylight, NSN 1240-01-169-8544 in support of the Light Armored Vehicle, ID# 08594A, TAMCN E0947, NSN 2320-01-123-1602.

3.0 REQUIREMENTS

3.1 GENERAL TASKS. The contractor shall repair the M36E2 Body Assembly, Daylight in accordance with TM 9-1240-380-34.

3.1.1 Government Furnished Equipment/Government Furnished Materiel. GFE is government owned equipment authorized by contract for use by a commercial/Government contractor. It is neither consumed during production nor incorporated into any product. GFM is materiel furnished to a contractor that will be consumed during the course of production or incorporated into the product being manufactured/remanufactured under a contract/statement of work. In the event the Marine Corps does have GFE/GFM requirements the Management Control Activity (MCA/G316-2), Marine Corps Logistics Bases, Albany, Georgia, will coordinate required GFE and will maintain a central control on Marine Corps assets in the Contractor's possession. The MCA will forward a GFE Accountability agreement to the Contractor Facility for signature to establish a chain of custody and property responsibilities for Marine Corps assets.

3.1.2 Contractor Furnished Materiel. In the event that Contractor Furnished Materiel (CFM) is required for repair parts, DOD 4000.25-1-M, (MILSTRIP) Chapter 11 authorizes the contractor to requisition through the DOD supply system. The procedures outlined in NAVICPINST 4491.2A shall be utilized in regards to the CFM.

3.2 QUALITY ASSURANCE PROVISIONS. The contractor shall provide and maintain a Quality System that as a minimum, adheres to the requirements of ANSI/ISO/ASQC/Q9003-1994 Quality Systems Model for Quality Assurance in Final Inspection and Test.

3.3 CONFIGURATION CONTROL. If it is necessary to depart from the authorized Bill of Material, the contractor shall submit a Request for Deviation (RFD) or Request for Waiver (RFW) using MIL-STD-973, paragraph 5.4.3 or 5.4.4 as guidance. Copies of engineering drawings/documents, Engineering Change Proposals (ECPs), and RFDs/RFWs may be obtained by accessing the Joint Engineering Data Management Information Control System (JEDMICS). 3.4 PACKAGING, HANDLING, STORAGE AND TRANSPORTATION (PHS&T)

a. The Contractor shall be responsible for preservation and packaging of items being repaired under the terms of this SOW. Items being prepared for shipment to overseas destinations or for long term storage shall be level "A" in accordance with MIL-STD-2073-1C, method 41. Items being prepared for domestic shipment and/or immediate use shall be Level "B."

b. Marking shall be in accordance with MIL-STD-129.

c. The Marine Corps will provide the contractor with the shipping address(es) for delivery of restored equipment. The contractor shall be responsible for arranging for shipment to the pre-designated site(s). The Marine Corps will be responsible for transportation costs associated with shipping the subject equipment to and from the Contractor.
