1.0 SCOPE. This Statement of Work (SOW) identifies the work effort that shall be performed by the contractor to rebuild the VHF Receiver Assembly, NSN 5895-01-355-8584. This receiver filters, amplifies and demodulates VHF signals for use by other components of the TRSS.

2.0 Applicable Documents. The following documents form a part of this SOW to the extent specified. Unless otherwise specified, the issues of these documents are those listed in the DoD Index of Specifications and Standards (DoDISS) and supplement thereto which is in effect on the date of solicitation. In the event of conflict between the documents referenced herein and the contents of this SOW, the contents of this SOW shall be the superseding requirement.

### 3.0 Requirements

3.1 The contractor shall rebuild the VHF receiver assembly in accordance with Technical Data Package 87001F1200.

3.2. The contractor shall establish, implement and document an ESD control program following the guidelines provided in EIA-625. ESD protective measures shall be used during rebuild, test, marking, packaging, storing and transporting the VHF Receiver.

3.3 Quality acceptance and test procedures shall be in accordance with the Test Requirements, drawing 87001F1208/CAGE 01365, contained in Technical Data Package 87001F1200.

3.4 Configuration Control. The contractor shall apply configuration control procedures to established configuration items. The contractor shall not implement configuration changes to an item's documented performance or design characteristics without receiving prior written authorization. The baseline configuration has been defined by documentation contained in Technical Data Package 87001F1200. If it is necessary to depart from the authorized configuration baseline, the contractor shall submit a Request for Deviation or Request for Waiver. MIL-STD-973 (paragraph 5.4.3 or 5.4.4. and Appendix E) may be used as a guide.

3.5 Quality Assurances Provisions. The contractor shall provide and maintain a Quality System that as a minimum, adheres to the requirements of ANSI/ISO/ASQC Q9003-1994, Quality System Model for Quality Assurance in Final Inspection and Test.

### 3.6 Packaging, Handling, Storage and Transportation (PHS&T).

a. The contractor shall be responsible for preservation and packaging of items being repaired under the terms of this statement of work. Items being prepared for long term storage or shipment to overseas destinations shall be to the Level "A" requirements of MIL-STD-2073-1C, Table A.VI, Electronic Equipment. Items being prepared for domestic shipment and/or immediate use shall be to Level "B."

b. Marking shall be in accordance with MIL-STD-129.

c. The Marine Corps will provide the contractor with the shipping address(es) for delivery of the repaired equipment. The contractor shall be responsible for arranging for shipment to the pre-designated site(s). The Marine Corps will be responsible for transportation costs associated with shipping the subject equipment to and from the Contractor.

3.7 Government Furnished Equipment (GFE)/Government Furnished Materiel (GFM). GFE is government owned equipment authorized by contract for use by a commercial/Government contractor. It is neither consumed during production nor incorporated into any product. GFM is materiel furnished to a contractor that will be consumed during the course of production or incorporated into product being manufactured/remanufactured under a contract/statement of work. In the event the Marine Corps does have GFE/GFM requirements, the Management

Control Activity (MCA/G316-2), Marine Corps Logistics Bases, Albany, Georgia, will coordinate required GFE and will maintain a central control on Marine Corps assets in the Contractor's possession. The MCA will forward a GFE Accountability agreement to the Contractor Facility for signature to establish a chain of custody and property responsibilities for Marine Corps assets. The Contractor shall report receipt of all GFM and report consumption of GFM to the MCA.

3.8 Contractor Furnished Materiel (CFM). The Marine Corps has adopted the Navy's procedures regarding Contractor Furnished Materiel (NAVICPINST 4491.2A). In the event that Contractor Furnished Materiel is required for repair parts, the contractor shall requisition through the DOD Supply System. DOD 4000.25-1-M, (MILSTRIP) Chapter 11 authorizes contractors to requisition through the DoD Supply System.
