1.0 SCOPE. This Statement of Work (SOW), along with RS 08487A-50/1, identifies the work effort that shall be performed by the contractor to rebuild the Enhanced Memory Digital Communication Terminal, NSN 5895-01-339-3686. This document contains requirements to restore the Enhanced Memory Digital Communications Terminal to Condition Code "A". Condition Code "A" is defined as serviceable/issuable without qualification, new, used, repaired or reconditioned materiel which is serviceable and issuable to all customers without limitation or restriction, including materiel with more than 6 months shelf-life remaining.

2.0 Applicable Documents. The following documents form a part of this SOW to the extent specified. Unless otherwise specified, the issues of these documents are those listed in the DoD Index of Specifications and Standards (DoDISS) and supplement thereto which is in effect on the date of solicitation. In the event of conflict between the documents referenced herein and the contents of this SOW, the contents of this SOW shall be the superseding requirement.

3.0 Requirements

3.1 The contractor shall rebuild the housing communication terminal in accordance with the technical data package 214500-110 / CAGE 13973 and rebuild standard RS 08487A-50/1 with change 1. Technical manual TM 08487C-30&P/3 is provided to assist the contractor.

3.2 Contractor Furnished Materiel. The Marine Corps has adopted the Navy's procedures regarding Contractor Furnished Materiel (NAVICPINST 4491.2A). In the event that Contractor Furnished Materiel is required for repair parts, the Contractor shall requisition through the DoD Supply System. DoD 4000.25-1-M, (MILSTRIP) Chapter 11 authorizes contractors to requisition through the DoD Supply System.

3.3 Handling of electrical and electronic devices to be in accordance with rebuild standard RS 08487A-50/1.

3.4 Quality acceptance and test procedures shall be in accordance with Technical Data Package 214500-110 / CAGE 13973 and rebuild standard RS 08487A-50/1 with change 1 requirements.

3.5 Configuration Control. If there is a need to temporarily depart from the established product baseline, the contractor shall prepare and submit a Request for Deviation or Request for Waiver. MIL-STD-973, paragraph 5.4.3, 5.4.4 and Appendix E may be used as a guide.

3.6 Quality Assurances Provisions. The contractor shall provide and maintain a Quality System that as a minimum, adheres to the requirements of ANSI/ISO/ASQC Q9003-1994, Quality System Model for Quality Assurance in Final Inspection and Test.

3.7 Packaging, Handling, Storage, and Transportation (PHS&T)

a. The Contractor shall be responsible for preservation and packaging of items being repaired under the terms of this statement of work. Items being prepared for long term storage or shipment to overseas destinations shall be level "A" in accordance with MIL-STD-2073-1C,

Appendix A, Table A.VI, Electronic Equipment. Items being prepared for domestic shipment or immediate use shall be preserved to level "B" requirements.

b. Marking shall be in accordance with MIL-STD-129.

c. The Marine Corps will provide the contractor with the shipping address for delivery of the repaired equipment and the contractor shall be responsible for arranging for shipment to the pre-

designated site. The Marine Corps will be responsible for transportation costs associated with shipping the equipment to and from the contractor.

3.8 Government Furnished Equipment (GFE)/Government Furnished Materiel (GFM) GFE is government owned equipment authorized by contract for use by a commercial/ government contractor. It is neither consumed during production nor incorporated into any product. GFM is materiel furnished to a contractor that will be consumed during the course of production or incorporated into the product being manufactured/remanufactured under a contract/statement of work. In the event the Marine Corps does have GFE/GFM requirements the Management Control Activity (MCA/822), Marine Corps Logistics Bases, Albany, GA, will coordinate required GFE and will maintain a central control on Marine Corps assets in the Contractor's possession. The MCA will forward a GFE Accountability agreement to the Contractor Facility for signature to establish a chain of custody and property responsibilities for Marine Corps assets.
